Based on the acclaimed bestseller by Dutch author Annejet van der Zijl, SONNY BOY is the exceptional based on true facts love story between two apparently ordinary people: typical Dutch Rika, mother of 4 children and a 17 years younger colored guy from Surinam called Waldemar. Their love survives all the presumptions and obstructions of the sometimes cruel outside world, but finally is unable to cope with the brutal and devastating power of the war.

In 1928, young Waldemar leaves his homeland Surinam. He goes to Holland to study. That's why his mother calls him an 'oceanswimmer'. In Holland, he's confronted with curiosity and misfortune because of discrimination, until he meets Rika, just divorced (with four children) who runs a boarding house.

They ultimately fall in love. The showpiece their hidden love is a young boy, whom they call 'Sonny Boy'. Because of this, Rika loses custody of her other four children and is thrown out of her house. With the help of Sam, an aged Jewish artist, they find a new home and again Rika starts a boarding house. After a period of relative happiness the volcano of World War2 erupts...

Rika and Waldemar are being asked hide refugees and Jews in their boarding house. They do so, until they are



betrayed. Both Rika and Waldemar are send to German Concentration Camps, while little Sonny Boy hides in a farm in the country.

Little Sonny Boy survives the war, but loses his parents... 'When there are grey skies, I don't mind the grey skies, you make them blue Sonny Boy...'
